Mukonde,

Thank you for the opportunity to review the proposed Title V initial permit for the following:

FACILITY NAME: Marana Regional Landfill
ACTION: Title V Permit - Initial
PERMIT: Title V Permit #6133

In accordance with the Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PCDEQ) regulations and 40 C.F.R. § 70.8(c), EPA has 45 days from receipt of the proposed permit and all necessary supporting documentation to object in writing to its issuance. With receipt of the proposed permit on June 11, 2012, the Agency's 45-day review period ends on **Wednesday, July 25, 2012**.

We reviewed the proposed permit and technical support document (TSD). We understand that PCDEQ responded to public comments and provided a copy of those responses for our consideration. Based on telephone conversations with PCDEQ regarding two comments we had (i.e., TSP emissions and SIP requirements, reference to applicability of 40 CFR Sec 258.21), we have no further comments, and understand PCDEQ will consider our comments as part of the final permit issuance.

Please note that the 60 day period for the public to petition the Administrator to object to the permit begins the day after EPA's 45 day review period would otherwise end. Please note that if the permit is later found to require corrective steps (including, but not limited to, reopening the permit for cause), the expiration of both EPA's review period and the public petition period without EPA objection does not compromise the agency's authority to take such measures.
