Subject: Pima County Hazardous Waste Generators Annual Permit Fee Adjustment

Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) is proposing revisions to the County's Environmental Quality Regulations (Title 7 of the Pima County Code). The proposed revisions affect the Hazardous Waste Generator Annual Permit Fee Schedule in Chapter 7.09.090.B. Please see the reverse side of this document for a table showing the proposed revisions.

These are the first proposed adjustments to these Annual Permit Fees in seventeen (17) years. The fees directly, and exclusively, provide cost recovery for the state-delegated Hazardous Waste Generator regulation program. To ensure complete program cost recovery, PDEQ has been mandated by the County's Board of Supervisors to seek these adjustments.

PDEQ will be holding a meeting to discuss these proposed revisions. You are invited to attend and participate in the discussion of the proposed changes to Title 7 of the Pima County Code.
